As you know, all of P.B.R.'s Anniversary bottles, both large and small, have been completely sold out. Since we wanted the miniature Wrangler to go primarily to those of you who bought the large Wrangler, only 600 miniatures were commissioned to be made in Japan. Orders received so far have been numbered and retained to guarantee that you can also receive the miniature Bronc Buster when it is issued. The Wrangler and Bronc Buster are the smallest amount produced of any P.B.R. bottles. As previously, they are being issued under the MBC label.

LET'S TALK

Incredibly enough, this is the end of our fourth year and we do hope that you've enjoyed the magazine and bottles as much as we have bringing it to you. In the last four years we've seen a great many changes in both the world of miniature bottles and in the magazine itself. We think those changes are all for the best!

Last time I told you about the new possible legislation allowing Californians to bring back liquor from Mexico in their cars. Well, it has been passed and signed. The first of the year you can start legally bringing those minis across the border.

The other new law and even more important for those of you who live here in California or those who plan on vacationing out our way is Assembly Bill No. 9 which was signed by Governor Brown on September 23rd. Are you ready? I quote: "Existing law prohibits the sale to consumers by such licensees of distilled spirits in packages containing less than 6 ounces. This bill would permit sales to consumers by such licensees of liqueurs, as defined, in packages containing 2 1/2 ounces or 75 milliliters." Our foot is now in the door!!!

This is a most interesting issue for us. You'll note that some of the things you might have expected aren't here and there are probably some surprises. Both Bill Odell's beer article (and it's a beaut with some excellent pictures) and Ruth Jones' Ski Country news got bumped due to those two incredible lists (Beam and scotch). We do have some great old Bal Tabarins for you though and the first article from Frank-Norbert Gerlach of Cologne, Germany. I know a lot of you whiskey collectors out there will be practically drooling when you see those bottles.

An annual event in many large cities in the U.S. is the September or October retailer liquor show. Shows were just completed in New York, Chicago, and here in L.A. From what I have heard of New York and Chicago, they were just as successful as the one here. Many Southern California collectors were lucky enough to get invited (it's not open to the public) and previewed the new miniatures from Lionstone, Hoffman, Cyrus Noble etc. All I can say is that there are certainly some great things in store. Lionstone has the mini Shootout at the OK Corral almost ready to go as well as minis of the last six western characters, the four latest birds, and the first two fire fighters. Hoffman has its Russell Western series ready soon and you'll see them all here.

Until next year, keep thing small.

As usual, the workmanship is the best, the characterization the finest, and the disappearance from the liquor store shelves the fastest. Look for these doggies "in the window" shortly after the first of the year.



WHAT'S NEW

Lots of new little goodies for you this time. In the last issue the pictures got rather washed out, possibly because we had them enlarged a bit too much, but you never know. Anyway, hope these pix turn out a good deal better.

The set of Stocks promised for this time has been held back until the next time because of limitations again.....and besides, just how many new items can you stand to see each time, particularly if you can't rush right out and buy them.

Leading off with the big guns and the biggest bottles, I'm certain you're as impressed by this set of three tall beauties as I was when I first saw them. As far as I know, these are only available in Reno as that's the only place they've been reported so far. And, they've been selling quietly up there for over

a year now I've been told.

Remember the Bralatta Mask ceramic from Italy years ago? Well, this is the same Bralatta and these are the same bottles as were used some years back. At that time they were an import; however, they are now filled in Union City. There are a variety of names at the bottoms of the labels but obviously they all come from the same place. In case you don't have a magnifying glass, they are from left to right: Licor de Kafiola, Grand Napoleon, and Liquorno Liqueur. It is this last one which states: "Specialty for Ditta Bralatta." I think they're the most beautifully done glass bottles currently available.

Turning now to the other set of bottles, we come to a most unusual grouping. The Loch-A-Moor is a Scotch Liqueur for all you Scotch collectors and is an-



other from Classic Liqueurs in Chicago. (Remember last time we had the Grand Suzette and Amaretto de Corso?) This is available in both Illinois and Wisconsin but I don't think for too much longer as I've heard all the Classic miniatures were being discontinued. This is possibly due to the metric switchover or the fact that it's ridiculously hard for most companies to buy plain glass bottles these days!

Next in line is the new Izmira Vodka. This is for "People of Good Taste" or so the label says. It's imported and bottled here by the Izmira Company of New York but the vodka itself is a product of Turkey. This bottle should be universally sold soon in all states which allow spirits as this company is running quite a campaign. Currently salesmen are giving away samples here in So. Cal. to liquor stores (yes,

that's legal). It sports a gorgeous label too.

The Heaven Hill is no great shakes, but it does have a new label and is only 80 proof. It recently made its appearance in Florida.

Another Florida find is the new 101 proof Eagle Rare ten year old bourbon. I guess the Old Prentice Distillery of Lawrenceburg, Kentucky figured that if success was found with a 101 proof Turkey, they'd try their luck with an Eagle.

Finally we have Bermuda Gold Liqueur. This is a rather plain bottle with an extremely good label and it's actually imported from Bermuda. I don't have any other bottle from Bermuda in my collection, do you? This one was found in Wisconsin.

Next time the Stocks and some cognacs. Who knows what else?

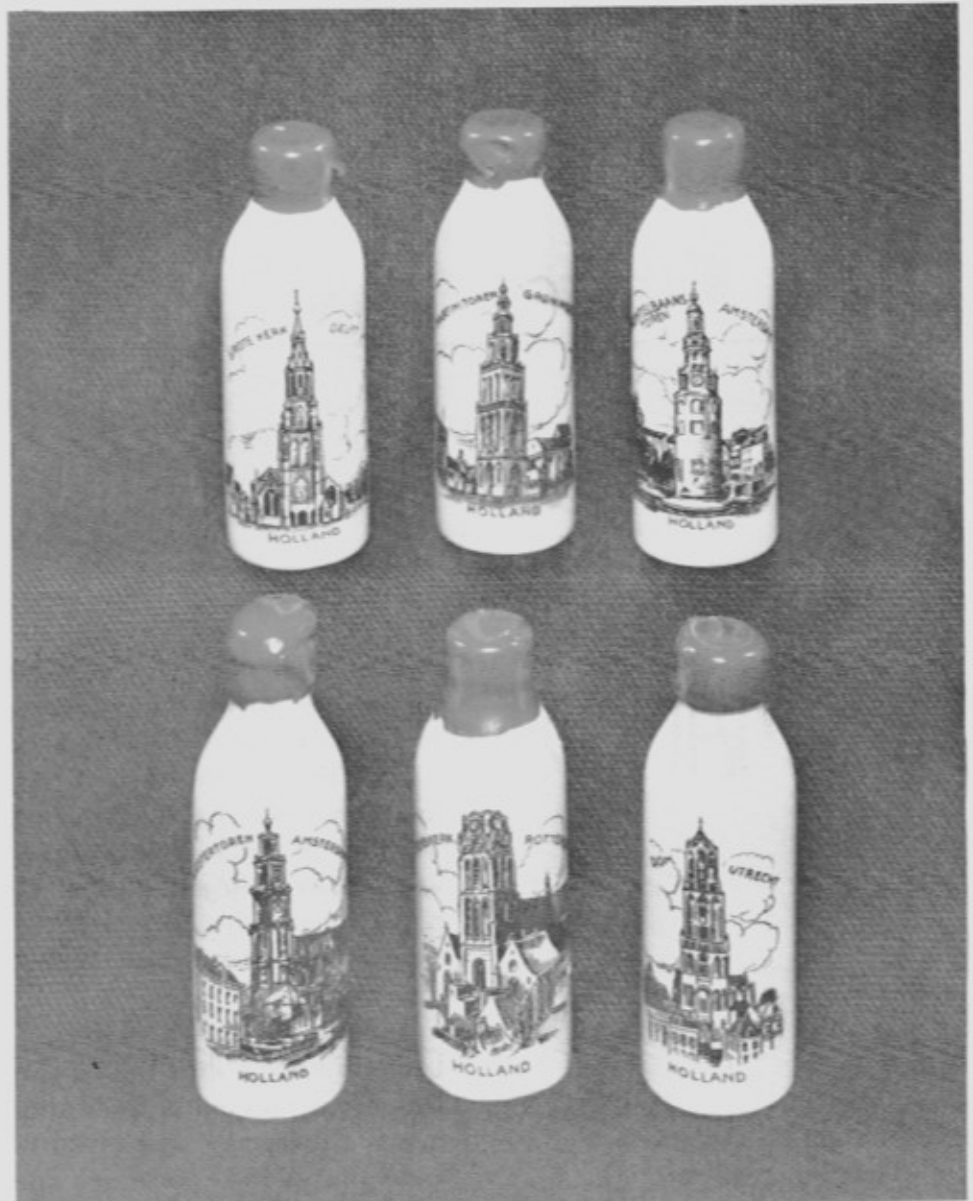
DELFT AND GLASS

The unique glass bottles may be familiar to some but have not been shown here before. The basic difference between these bottles and those sold 40 years ago is that these are screw tops.

PETERS HERMANOS

Pictured here are nine more of the products of Peters Hermanos of Buenos Aires. All the spirits and liqueurs are produced in Caseros (province of Buenos Aires). The firm has been in this location since the plant started working in 1952. Peters also is well known in Argentina for importing both the Ricard Pastis from France and Strega Liqueur from Italy.

The slightly taller bottle is Lacrado Brandy while the La Cra Do shown previously was a liqueur. There are two English style gins: Black Prince and Pe-

ters London Dry. Baker and Baxter is a quality whisky produced with malts distilled and aged in Scotland and then mixed with the local grain alcohols in imported oak casks.

The five liqueurs are Guindado (?), Coffee with Cognac, Prunelle, Maraschino, and Peppermint. A complete line of liqueurs still awaits to be shown; however, as of now, the extensive line of wines and champagnes are not produced in miniature. More liqueurs will be featured another time.

BAL TABARIN

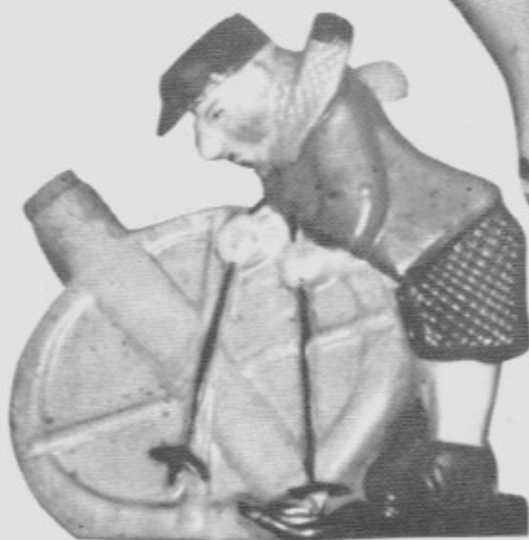
If you're a bottle scavenger who haunts the swap meets, flea markets, garage sales (and an occasional antique show), you may have had the good fortune of finding a Bal Tabarin bottle. The six bottles shown here on this page are all rare Bal Tabarins and are part of a set of at least a score of interesting pieces all made between 25 and 30 years ago.

The dba was the Ron Virgin Rum Company but the bottles were actually produced by Federal Distillers of Cambridge, Massachusetts. The ceramics were made in Occupied Japan and are all so marked (on the bottom). With the upswing in collecting of "Made in Occupied Japan" articles, many of these bottles may not be in bottle collectors' hands.

As far as is now known, all the bottles contained Blackberry Liqueur. Since the bottles were sold probably in only Massachusetts and one or two other states (Florida and Maryland), they are usually seen in east coast collections and are quite uncommon...no matter what part of the country.

One note. The Nineteenth Hole is also available as a Japanese giveaway slightly different in coloring and design. Whereas the giveaway is relatively common, the Bal Tabarin is not and if you're buying at an inflated price, make certain there's a label.

Another group of Bal Tabarin bottles will be seen next time.

From El Monte, California, meet the collectors' collector. This is Mr. Linus Earl and as the subject of a Meet The Collector column, Linus is long overdue.

The term "collectors' collector" certainly isn't used lightly as there just aren't many around who have given the hours and devotion that Linus has. And what has he got to show for it? Well, would you believe several thousand bottles?

As you can tell from some of the pictures, whiskies (bourbons and ryes) are his main interest but don't think that any other type of glass or figural bottle has been slighted. They're all there, from the Luxardo Chess



set and Snow White and the Seven Dwarfs in the figural end to pre-prohibition whiskies in the glass section.

German Whiskies

I am very happy to be writing this article for you about my hobby. In Germany miniature bottle collectors are very few and I can't find many friends with this same hobby. And then, I specialize and collect only whisky miniatures....but from the entire world. Now I want to show you some "exotics" or rarities.

After the war, whisky begins to arrive in Germany. Because of its success, many German distillers try to make "German Whisky." However, this is not a success and today only three or four German distilleries still make whisky. I have never even tasted it as I like to drink a good bourbon or malt.

In the first picture you can see on the left the whisky called Doppelschluck. This name means "drinking twice." On the right is the Old Sir Whisky made by Fugger Distillery in Munich. Old Sir is no longer made and cannot be found anywhere.

In the next picture there is (on the left) a whisky from Co-

logne. This is Sieger Whisky and is now only available in large bottles. Next to it is Mohikaner and it is no longer made as a whisky at all. This distillery now makes only liqueurs and gin.

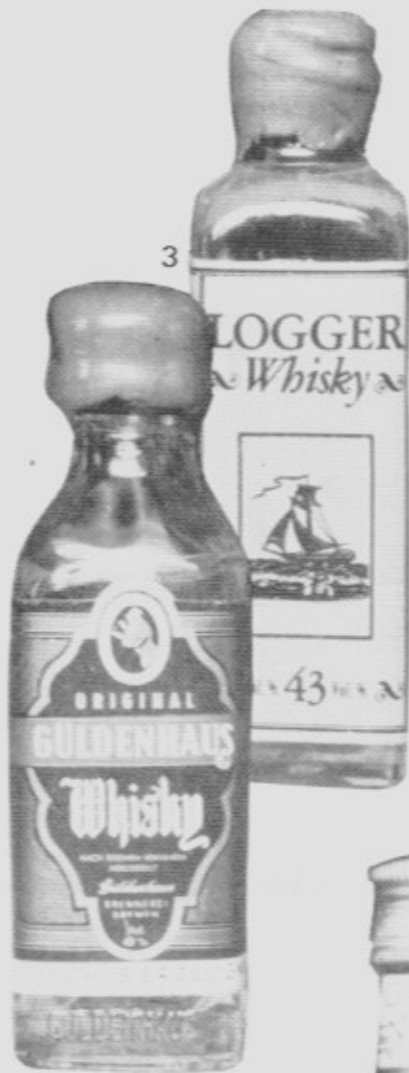
The third picture has the two oldest of all the bottles. These are Guldenhaus and Logger. Both come from a distillery in Bremen.

In my next picture are two similarly labeled bottles but from two different places. The 1814 is from Cologne while the other is from Northern Germany.

Finally in the last picture, you see on the left the Mercedes Whisky.....which comes from Stuttgart just like the Mercedes automobile. The Rhenus Whisky on the right is no longer available and today this distillery only makes mineral water and gin.

You may have noticed that I have sealed many of my bottles with wax. I am particular and do not want them to evaporate.

MICROMINIS

If you recall, in my last article. Flo and I were anticipating the arrival of a new miniature. Well, the miniature has arrived - on August 19 and happens to be the best miniature we own. His name is Thomas, and he weighed 8 pounds.

Enough for announcements, now let's talk about some rums.

First of all, the three Rums featured are all Gold Seal miniatures. Beginning the trio is a 2 3/4" Taplow's White Ensign Old Jamaica Rum bearing a very colorful, picturesque label. The British flag is centered within nautical cord on a red background and a nautical scene also appears on the label. A Pilgrim's profile is encircled above as well as being embossed in the back. This is the Taplow's trademark.

The middle of the picture shows a 3 1/4" Lemon Hart Golden Jamaica Rum, sporting a gold, brown, red, white, green, and black label. A work scene is also depicted here, featuring rum kegs as well as a Clipper ship unloading these kegs.

Also standing 3 1/4" is a Lamb's Demerara Navy Rum. The gold, red, white and blue label also sports the British flag and states that it is a product of British Guiana. The contents of this bottle appear to be a reddish liquid.

Before closing, I would like to give credit to two people in particular who have been very helpful to me over the years in obtaining miniatures, namely Harold Goetz and Linus Earl.

The two Doctor giveaway bottles shown here were probably given away in case of extreme hangover.

The Drinkometer has the thermometer in the back. By placing your thumb over the bulb at the bottom, it takes about three seconds for the fluid to race up the tube to the TAKE ONE DRINK mark. Starting at the bottom, the marks read: Normal, Dry, Very Dry, Thirsty, Take 1 Drink, and Take 2 Drinks. The doctor on this flask is carrying an orange colored bag. It has a skull and

crossbones on it. The front of the flask has the doctor in multicolor on a brown background. The left side is embossed "The Doctor", spelled with an "e". There is another without a thermometer in back that is spelled with the "o". This is probably a later model. Below is embossed "Use It Daily, You'll Live Gaily" It stands 5 1/4 inches tall plus the cap. I found this one in Spokane for \$16. It has Vancouver Canada in black print on the

bottom.

The smaller of the doctor bottles is only 4 1/4 inches tall. He too is carrying an orange bag. It reads Dr. Health and has two very large needles sticking out of it. He is in multicolor also. The small flask which he is attached to is all brown and has Pain Expeller embossed on it.

Yes, either one of these would be an appropriate giveaway on the morning after. --LM--

To, shall we say, close out 1977, I'm going to go back to some assorted straight whiskey bottles that I was lucky in finding in the last two months (written in 1976). Even though most antique dealers have somehow learned to charge outrageous prices for common airline bottles, I was fortunate in making a few friends amongst them and they call me periodically when they scrounge up some minis.

The five inch Grant's Blended Scotch Whisky is 8 years, 86 US proof, pull tab and has a Florida 1953, light green, 7 1/2 cent tax stamp. Some other of the Grant versions may be found on the front page of the Feb-March 1975 issue of MBM.

The Glayva, or as it means "superlative" in Gaelic, should be added to the three versions shown by Tony Natelli in the April 1974 issue of MBM. It's 80 proof, green glass, black background paper label, and corked with a small tartan sash attached to the neck of the bottle.

Another version of B.P.R. (Baltimore Pure Rye) where the capital letters are in a perfect circle is shown here. This bottle is marked "reverse" blended whiskey(?) It is 86 proof with a black metal twist cap and in amber glass.

A Maryland product is the E. M. Fleischmann's Special blended whiskey. This is also in amber glass but comes in at a larger 90 proof.

The Barclay's Seven Cup which

depicts a gold cup behind the number 7 is 80.6 proof, 3 years old and a real beauty in my opinion.

The Crosse & Blackwell Bay Side blended whiskey is another 86 proof with a metal twist cap. It shows a three masted ship against a white sky with tress in the foreground. It has a red label.

The Foust Pennsylvania Rye is a five year old 84.6 proof. It states that the Foust Distilling Company of Glen Rock, PA has been around since 1840 but this was bottled by Sherwood Distilling of Westminster MD.

My last offering for this column is a gold label Three Virgins West Indies rum (86 proof). I know it's not a whiskey, but it's a great bottle. This was imported and bottled by Dundalk Liquor Company of Baltimore.

So much has been written in past issues of *The Lilliputian Gulliver's Gazette*, the *MBC*, and *MBM* about sharing information and contributing material, but I must return to the subject. My "pet peeve" has been for some time the collectors who never answer their mail or questions asked of them. I've said it in the past and I'll say it again:

"What is the great secret?" Why can't some share a few lines about a certain bottle or its origin?

I must confess that at times I am also even guilty of the above; however, my guilt lies in the retribution factor. Share with me and I'll share with you. Perhaps it's the wrong attitude on my part but I am willing to learn and willing to admit my errors. Now, do I hear some rumbling in the aisles? Drop me a note otherwise...or, let me know your pet peeve.

In the interest of time and space, this list of Beam miniatures includes only white label miniatures with the personalized titles appearing in gold-framed oblongs on the lower front of the labels. Personalized Spey Royal minis, Beam's Choice minis and a miscellaneous category will appear in the next issue of the MBC, as well as additions to the white label category.

These labels are listed in the order of the very first letter on the label. For instance, the label which says Del Webb's Mint Hotel is listed under D, but the label that says simply Mint Hotel is listed under M. We have determined that this is the best way for collectors to find what they are looking for. We are making no attempt to list them in strict alphabetical order within each letter category simply because when we add to the list, they will be out of order anyway.

The bottles are rated according to values in trading, known as Trade Units. Most bottles are rated "1" which means it is on a one-for-one trading basis--trade these bottles even across the board. However if the bottle is listed, for example, as having 4 Trade Units then this indicates that it is equal to four bottles in the "1" category or any number of bottles totaling 4. If a bottle is listed as having 10 Trade Units then it would take any number of bottles totaling 10 to trade for that bottle. These Trade Units are derived from knowledge picked up at attendance at Conventions, Bottle shows, Beam meetings, trade sessions, etc. At this point, they are based on what we believe to be sound judgment but, of course, are subject to change. If you have any reasons to sug-

gest changes in our ratings, please write me. These values are flexible and will be up-dated from time to time.

The bottles are numbered under each letter category so that they can be referred to as A-3, or P-2, and so on. Those shown with an asterisk indicate that the label is the new one which says "This Whiskey is 5 Years Old."

The listings are shown exactly as they appear on the bottles: exact characters on each line and whether upper or lower case or a combination of both. For example, look at DESERT DOLL HOUSE, Hawthorne, Nevada. The words DESERT DOLL appear on the first line of the label all in capital (upper case) letters; the word HOUSE is on the second line, all in caps; the words Hawthorne, Nevada, are on the third line in upper and lower case letters. Making this type of listing is, of course, very time consuming but we have done it in this manner because there are often second runs of labels for Beam customers and the second run differs from the first in either layout or type of letters. Consequently, we have two different bottles.

I am, of course, aware that there are many more Beam white label personalized miniatures than I have listed here...but I have listed only those of which I am certain of the layout and letter types. If you want a bottle to be included in these listings I will need to know exactly what words are on each line and whether all words are in upper or in lower case or a combination. 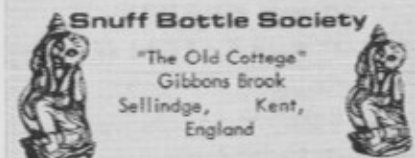
