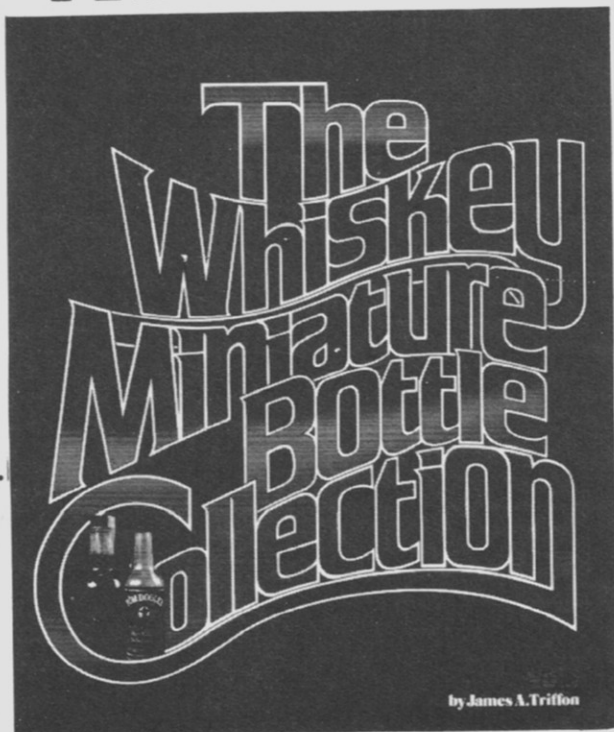

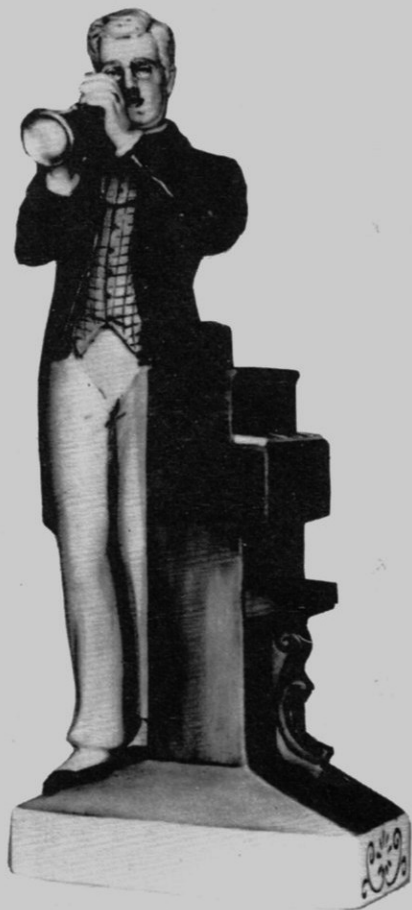

CYRUS NOBLE





It isn't often we get to show you four new miniatures from Cyrus Noble, but here they are. A great many collectors have been eagerly awaiting the Trum-pet Player or Middle of the Piano and the Mine minis as these complete the entire Mine Series. If you've got the entire series, you've got yourself a very nice display.

Beginning with the Miner, Bartender, and Assayer in late 1974, the series is complete if you have all fourteen pieces. The others in the group are: Gambler, Burro, Landlady, Musician, Blacksmith, Miner's Daughter, Whiskey Drummer, Gambler's Lady, and Violinist. Some consider Snowshoe Thomson part of the set; however, he is an individual bottle, no matter how

well he "fits". If you're missing any of these, they may all still be found except for the Gambler's Lady and no more of those are available.

The other two bottles have also been awaited for some time now. The Moose and Bear (yes, they will both have the wooden stands) are numbers three and four in the miniature Wildlife Series. The picture shown here is of an early sample of the Bear mini and the finished product will be only slightly different. The Moose will remain the same.

All in all, four extremely nice bottles to add to your Christmas list. Just think what marvelous stocking stuffers each one would make!

Think I will start my fifth article by reviewing the past ones a little bit.

In Jan-Feb for my first article, I wrote on my collection. Also showed pictures of other mini beer collectors.

In March-April, my pictures didn't turn out, so I didn't make it; however, thanks to Scott Spaid... I was covered.

In May-June I wrote on the mini wooden beer openers I found while visiting in Mexico.

In July-August I wrote on the follow-

ing beers: Arrow foil label 4" Imperial Lagered Beer by the Globe Brewing Co., Baltimore, Maryland. They were in business from 1933-63. I also understand there's a stubby. Does anyone have one? If so, please send me a picture of it. The Acme's of course have all different labels and come from Los Angeles or San Francisco. The 4 1/4" Lager (from what I read) was by a Cereal Products Refining Corporation in San Francisco. The oldest of



the Acme's is from 1923-34. The others from 1934-54.

In Sept-Oct I showed the Acme stubbies. Once again they were all different (from L. A. or S. F.) and they came from 1934-54. I also showed the Atlantic Ale from Charlotte, N.C. Sorry I couldn't picture the beer.

Now this time we'll begin with the Apache Beer. This is a decal label, very pretty - mostly green and gold. At least I think it's green and gold, can't tell too much from mine. Am I right, Irv? Sorry don't mean to pick on you...ok) Does anyone have an Apache Ale?

Next we have two American beers. First is the American 4 1/4" by the American Brewing Company, Baltimore. They were in business from 1933-72. The next is the American Bock Beer, a 3" stubby. This may only have been in business from 1933-58. It was known as the John F. Weissner Brewing Co.

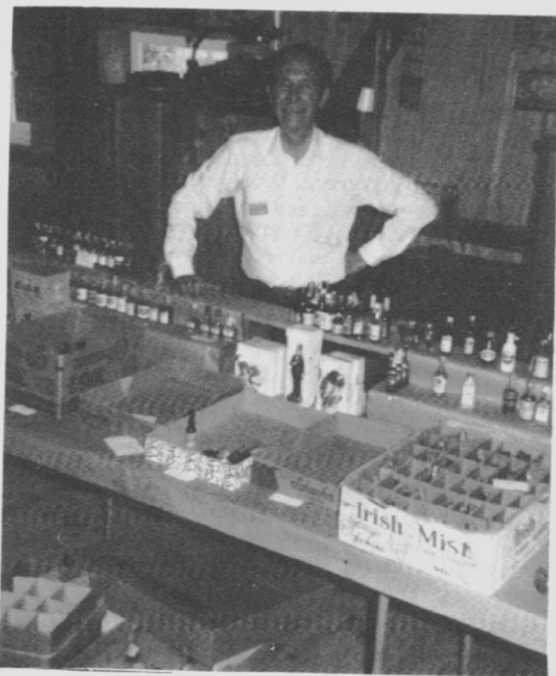

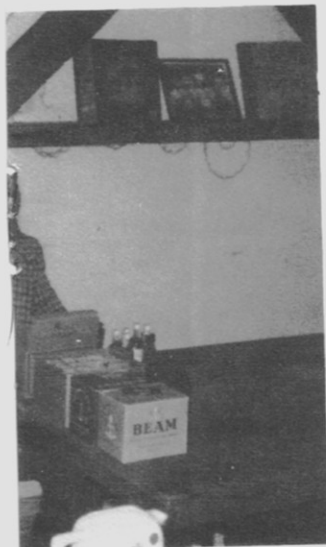

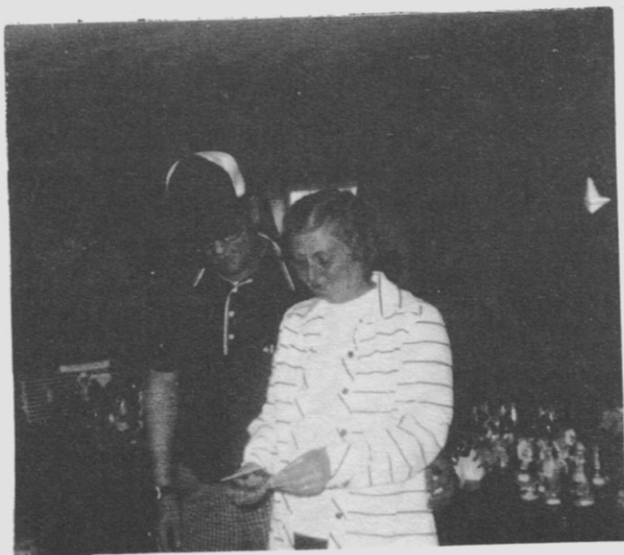

This time I'd like to feature three bottles from the Distillers Corporation of Montreal, Canada. They are what I would consider three of the finest miniatures in my collection. The quality and workmanship is superior in regard to the label and embossing. These bottles are not pre-prohibition, but were bottled during the mid-1920's, seen from time to time, but certainly not easy to come by.

An Old Log Cabin Bourbon is first, featuring the picture of a log cabin on the label. The bottle is embossed with trees and a log cabin on the back with the words "Old Log Cabin Bourbon Whiskey." It carries a 1926 Canadian Revenue Stamp.

Next is a Mellwood Bourbon Whiskey with a very picturesque label depicting a cellar full of aging vats. It too is embossed; the design resembling a wood grain effect. A keg is embossed in the back, surrounded by the words "Mellwood Bourbon Whiskey - Mellowed in Wood."

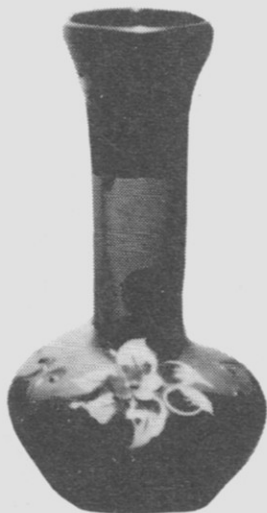
Last, the Lincoln Inn Rye is of the same shape as the other two; however, it is not embossed. It is a corker, unlike the other two that have screw caps. It has a 1925 Canadian Revenue Stamp.

There are other ryes and bourbons by Distillers Corporation Limited, however, I have not had the good fortune of finding them as of yet!

From the tallest, which measures nine inches, to the shortest, measuring 3 1/4 inches, I certainly hope you like them. Originally they're from Italy and came from the Monaci della Certosa company.

KORD & JELINEK

There are many collectors across the United States who prize most highly their exquisite Venetian glass decanters imported by Mr. Fuchs of Imported Brands under the Bischoff label. From 1948 to 1971, Mr. Fuchs, President of Imported Brands, imported Bischoff and Kord liqueurs in choice glass and ceramic bottles. His glass decanters are unequaled today in any other line.

Collectors have also been interested in the Kord and Jelinek glass miniatures he imported from Czechoslovakia. These were imported from 1948 to 1971. Mr. Fuchs retired in 1972 and these delightful miniatures are no longer imported into the United States. The shapes of the miniatures are very appealing and the colorful labels are very attractive. These glass bottles appeal to collectors of the "straight" miniatures and are not usually included in the collections of figural bottles.

Some collectors are puzzled because there are two sizes of most of the Kord miniatures and wonder if both sizes were imported at the same time, and if not, which is the oldest - the smaller size or the larger? Quite often with many distilleries, the smaller size is the oldest but this is not true of the Kord miniatures. In most cases, the newest ones are the smallest in size. This can be determined by the tax stamps.

In 1948, the Czechoslovakian government arranged an exhibit of both liqueurs and fancy bottles in New York. Mr. Samuel Fuchs was studying law at the time and was also working as a salesman in a liquor store. He became aware of how many buyers asked for something "in a pretty bottle." He was

impressed with the exhibition and decided to devote all his energies in importing excellent quality liqueurs in distinctively designed bottles.

The Kord Distilleries are located in Hradec Kralove, in a fertile region known as the "Golden Road" where habitation has existed since pre-historic times. The Bohemian town is at the confluence of the Orlice and the Elbe Rivers. The Rudolf Jelinek Distilleries are located at Vizovice, Czechoslovakia. Mr. Fuchs became the exclusive agent for Kord Liqueurs and Jelinek Brandies.

Mr. Fuchs began importing the miniatures in 1948 and continued with some of them until he retired. Some of these miniatures have tax stamps with the address of "Imported Brands, Inc., New York, N. Y." These are the older ones. The later ones have a different address: "Imported Brands Inc. Brooklyn, N. Y. 11201." Most of the Kord and Jelinek "straights" were imported during the early years and some again in 1969. Many of the Horse's Heads were brought in at this time and made available to collectors. Then in late 1971 Mr. Fuchs bade farewell to his many years of choosing, designing and distributing fancy decanters. He is now enjoying his retirement in East Hampton, Long Island, about 100 miles from New York. He loves fishing and the country life. Perhaps he looks back with regret on the years of excitement in designing new bottles, but as he says, "bright in his memories are all the beautiful people associated with bottle collecting."

I will indicate the bottles with the Brooklyn tax stamps, all the others have the older address.

Kentucky, Minnesota, Mississippi, New Hampshire, Oklahoma, Rhode Island, Virginia, and Pennsylvania. SPECIAL ORDER, CASE LOTS ONLY: North Carolina, Maine, Washington. AIRLINE & RAILROADS ONLY: Missouri, Nebraska, Louisiana (where they seemed a bit unsure exactly what the law was). AVAILABLE AT SPECIALTY STORES: West Virginia.

"I've saved Vermont for last, where according to a delightful matron at Vermont's ABC, they carry two: Haig & Haig 5* and Frangelico... otherwise nothing."
