



WHAT'S NEW







The regular mix again this time but with rather a tip of the scale in favor of some new scotches. Let's begin with an update of an old favorite, FINLANDIA. Recently the focus of an entire make over, this new Finlandia features a complete bottle change as well as a new label. Note the little group of reindeer underneath the Vodka. It should be available everywhere in the U.S. as well as most of the rest of the world.

We seem to have had a good number of tequilas lately shown in the magazine, so we'll keep up the string with these two new ones, DUENO and PUERTO VALLARTA. The former is available on both the east and west coasts while

the latter may still only be found in California.

Don't know if the new ST. AN-DREWS FRANCE '98 WORLD CUP is in the U.S. as this one was found in Canada. It's the same as previous soccer balls except for the new base...which, of course, makes it very attractive to both soccer lovers and scotch collectors!

We have three other scotches now which have just come on the market in Scotland. Collector Bert Thomson sent me these on a trade (a small reminder that it pays to contact other collectors). The TAMNAVULIN is merely a new label but the other two are quite special.

This OLD PULTENEY is really a



Whisky which comes in its own wooden box. There have been several very nice special Glengoyne bottles in the last few years, but this just might be the nicest. Note that it's cask strength at 56.2% or 112.4 proof. Whee.

Now it may not be best, but it is last. And, any way you look at it, this one is rather something else. I'm speaking of BIBLE BELTER





15 Years Old Kentucky
Bourbon. If you remember the
Old Rip Van Winkle of a few issues
back, you'll know that it was also a
15 year old so one would have to
bet that this contains that whiskey.
It was bottled in Scotland by The
Whisky Connoisseur and someone
there has a great sense of humor.
The label features a whiskey
bottle, a glass and the bible. Just

Last time I said I'd show you a group of bottles all done in series; however, I've changed my mind. That can wait. Several collectors told me in St. Louis that they enjoyed the "old and new" articles, so here is another. I'll talk about the new ones first and save the good older ones for later.

I know my friend Tony Natelli has shown the SCOTTISH LEADER bottle previously but I wanted you to see the new label. And this is also a new label for the 10 year old TULLIBARDINE Single Highland Malt. Both of these should be quite easy to obtain.



A bit more difficult to find are the pair issued by The Whisky Connoisseur, the DRAM OF DES-TINY and the DEVOLUTION DRAM. The first one commemorates the return of the Stone of Destiny to Scotland in September of 1996. The Devolution commemorates the "Yes" vote in 1977 for a new Parliament for Scotland. This is a true mini and only 25 casks were set aside to make this special whisky. Since the overwhelming majority of those went to 70cl bottles, there aren't that many of the miniatures about.

In looking at these four older bottles, I realize that some of you may know SANDY MACNABS and HIGHLAND LAIRD from different bottlings. These two names should not be unfamiliar to most collectors. However, ANDER-SON'S and CRESPHER are two not often seen. I am particularly interested in the latter bottle as bottled for either Italy or Spain and I believe only available as an export.

BURLINGAME, CREAM OF WHISKIES, 1915, is a white ceramic bottle stamped Germany on the bottom. Burlingame is the city I live in! Next is BROOKFIELD RARE OLD PERFECT RYE dated 1867, a brown ceramic jug. I really love this one, too.



OLD 49er, a California whiskey, has a white, gold and black label. It's from 1937 and is the only one I've ever seen.

Next I have two spirit whiskeys from California: OLD VELVET with a red, white and blue label and LITTLE FRISCO SPIRIT WHISKEY. It has a silver and black label just like the LITTLE FRISCO RECTIFIED WHISKEY which is also a California bottle.

We then have the H L C BLENDED WHISKEY, another

California mini from San Francisco. This one has more "story" behind it though. The "H" of HLC stands for Haas, a company with a long San Francisco history including the name Cyrus Noble!

Last (best?) is POLO'S STUD HORSE WHISKEY, Special Baby Celebration Blend. I have also pictured the back label for your reading pleasure.

I hope you've enjoyed seeing my minis as much as I've enjoyed presenting them to you. --F.H.--











Four different but super additions to any collection are featured in this month's article. The first is one of several FOUR ACES. This is the clear flask that has a green label with red and white letters. This blended whiskey is 90 proof. This whiskey was blended and bottled for Four Aces Liquor Corporation, Boston, Mass.

The second bottle is O L D GRAND-DAD WHISKEY and it's 100 proof. This one was bottle in 1917.

The third miniature is CHICKEN COCK. The clear round bottle was used by several different companies. As you can see, the label has a multi-colored rooster in the center. This blended whiskey is 90 proof.

The last mini is HIRAM WALKER'S EPICURE AMERICAN BLENDED SCOTCH WHISKY (the only scotch in this article). The scotch is 86 proof and the bottle is a brown embossed flask.

Hope you enjoyed these great old whiskies. 'Til next time, Butch.

FRORZ FARAR







This time I would like to present to you some Japanese Whisky miniatures which were issued in the first half of 1998.

The first is SUNTORY NEW SHIRO-KAKU. SUNTORY SHIRO (white)-KAKU (square) means a square bottle with white label in contrast to SUNTORY KAKU with vellow label. NEW HIRO-KAKU

was an up grade in quality and has a different white cap from SHIRO KAKU (golden cap). On the label were added four Japanese letters which means "clear and dry".

KIRIN-SEAGRAM ROBERT BROWN SPECIAL BLEND is a new 40% version from Robert Brown. The label is a bit smaller



with a bar code and has a black cap.

SUNTORY OLD, as you know, is very familiar to us and is one of the representative whiskies of Japan. The NEW OLD is 40% version from OLD and the quality was also changed to a more mild and smooth whiskey as you can see on the label. Usually when the new version is launched, the production of the old version is stopped (eg. NEW SHIRO KAKU and ROBERT BROWN, etc., etc.); however, there are still available the OLD and the NEW.

The next miniatures are two Pure Malt Whisky miniatures from Suntory. ZEN is a new brand and means a small dining table. The bottle is an opposite trapezoidal fancy type. It is 8.5cm tall in clear glass and contains 50ml at 40% alcohol. HAKUSHU 10 year old (from Hakushu Distillery) has a light green label on green glass and is 40% alcohol, the same as YAMAZAKI 10 year old.

The last, KIRIN-SEAGRAM BOSTON CLUB, was not released on 1998. This pet bottle was available about two years ago hanging on the big bottle as a tasting sample.

(Ed. Note: Blackadder International was kind enough to send us the labels shown and to provide a bit of information too. For those who would like to go on-line to send a message or ask a question, the e-mail adress is enquiries@blackadder.com Currently there are a good number of whiskies available under several different labels.)

Blackadder and Limited Edition whiskies are the personal selections of John Lamond and Robin Tucek, authors of *The Malt Whisky File* (now over 100,000 copies in print). All the whiskies, both large and small, are bottled without chill filtration and without the addition of caramel colouring. Under certain temperature conditions, these whiskies may appear

slightly cloudy or "milky". In order to filter out suspended fats which can cause cloudiness and sedimentation in the bottle, the usual practice is to chill the spirit to below freezing point prior to bottling. This removes possibility of cloudiness, unfortunately also removes a great deal of the individual character of a whisky as the esters, or flavour congeners, in the spirit tend to gather around these fats. The more a whisky is chilled when filtering, therefore, the greater the proportion of fats and removed.

The above will explain a great deal to collectors who have wondered why some of their bottles' contents look a bit murky. As of this past June, sixteen different miniatures were available.

WATCH BOTTLES Part III

George Morton, Ltd. Produced at least three watch bottles, circa the 1960's, including MORTON'S BLENDED SCOTCH, MORTON'S SPECIAL RESERVE SCOTCH and O.V.D. RUM. Some collectors are lucky enough to own these!

TULLAMORE DEW (Irish Whiskey) put out at least four different and all are top notch minis, especially the first two, both corkers (pictured). An 8 year old (pictured) and a 10 year old (not shown) are somewhat newer but not often seen.

The CASTLE GRAND J.J.
DUBLIN WHISKEY is a real

knockout and this one may be the only known version. Our final bottle is a MINE HOST FAMILY SHERRY with a magnificent multicolored label put out by J. G. Thomson some 4-50 years ago. They are also responsible for the R.A. SCOTCH mentioned in our second watch column. A MIMOSA SHERRY has also been seen as a watch mini.

Some other watch bottles to look for are A. Dupont, Renault, and Otard. All contain cognac and are next to impossible to obtain.

In this article I would like to feature three pre-pro Ryes, plus we'll look at four bottles from the more recent past. I have managed to pick up a few pre-pros this year and bottles four and five came from the 1998 St. Louis Mini show.

Anyway, we lead off with ELKHURST PURE RYE WHISKEY Distilled by Neal, Hoffman & Co. Covington, Kentucky. It dates from the turn of the century.

Bottle two is HERMITAGE
PURE RYE WHISKEY Distilled by
Hermitage Distillery, Franklin Co.,
Ky. It was BIB 1892-1899. This company also produced Old Crow
Brand and both reemerged in the
1930's as part of National Distillers,
Inc. I featured a variation of this
brand which was BIB 1906-1914 in
MBC #72.

The last pre-pro is SOLO RYE Blended by Straus Bros. of Chicago. It is "Best on the Bars" and is post-

1906.

The KENTUCKY RIVER STRAIGHT BOURBON WHISKEY was distilled by Kentucky River Distilling Co., Nicholasville, Ky. It is 86 proof, four years old and is one of the popular square bottles from the 1950's and '60's.

The next bottle is a real sleeper and was totally unknown to me. It is MARYLAND GENTLEMAN STRAIGHT BOURBON WHISKEY Bottled by Montebello (Pride of Baltimore) Liquors Inc. of Baltimore. It is 80 proof, 6 years old and from 1960.

Bottle six is FOUR SCORE KENTUCKY STRAIGHT BOURBON WHISKEY Bottled at 86 proof, circa 1960 by County Line Distillers, Bardstown, Ky. The last of these is YANKEE STRAIGHT RYE WHISKEY Bottled at 100 proof, circa 1950 by Connecticut Corp., Concord, Connecticut.






